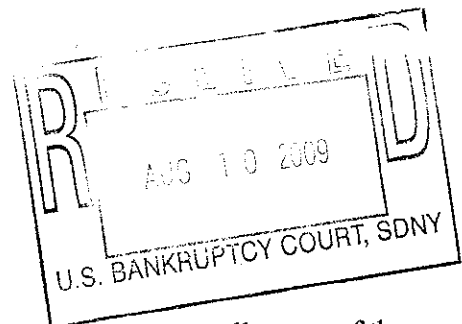
**SUPPLEMENTAL**
