Dear Judge Glenn:

Jones Day and Munger, Tolles & Olson LLP are co-counsel to well over 100 defendants representing approximately \$600 million of the principal of the Term Loan outstanding on June 30, 2009 (collectively, the "Term Loan Lenders"). John Spiegel of Munger Tolles and I are colead counsel on this case for our respective firms.
