MOTION FOR ADMISSION TO PRACTICE, *Pro Hac Vice*

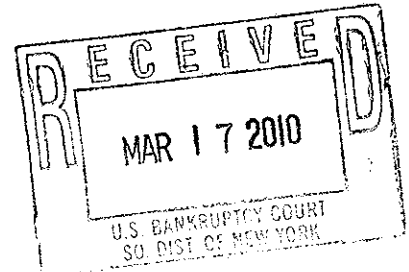
