**NOTICE OF HEARING ON PLAINTIFFS'
MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**

**TO DEFENDANT GENERAL MOTORS COMPANY, f/k/a NEW GENERAL MOTORS
COMPANY, INC:**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on November 16, 2009, Plaintiffs and Class Representatives, Kelly Castillo, Nichole Brown, Brenda Alexis Digiandomenico, Valerie Evans, Barbara Allen, Stanley Ozarowski, and Donna Santi, individually and on behalf of all others similarly situated (collectively "Plaintiffs"), filed a Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order and a Memorandum In Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order, which seek an

order: (a) preserving the status quo by prohibiting New GM from engaging in ex parte communications or business transactions, directly or through others, with the represented Plaintiffs and other class members in a manner inconsistent with the terms of the Class Judgment, except to the extent they are simultaneously advised of their rights under the Class Judgment, in particular, that the class member may be entitled to reimbursement of up to 100% of his or her VTi transmission related expenses, that this Court is reviewing Plaintiffs' claim that New GM assumed Old GM's liability under the Class Judgment, and that additional information regarding class members' rights may be obtained at no cost through class counsel (along with contact information); (b) prohibiting New GM from obtaining releases or arguing accord and satisfaction; (c) setting a briefing schedule and a date for hearing on a preliminary injunction at the Court's earliest convenience; and (d) expedited discovery on issues pertinent to a preliminary injunction, including communications to class members regarding the new special policy.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that a hearing to consider the entry of a temporary restraining order has been scheduled for November 18, 2009 at 2:00 p.m. before the Honorable Robert E. Gerber and will be held at the Bankruptcy Court, One Bowling Green, Room 621, New York, New York 10004.
